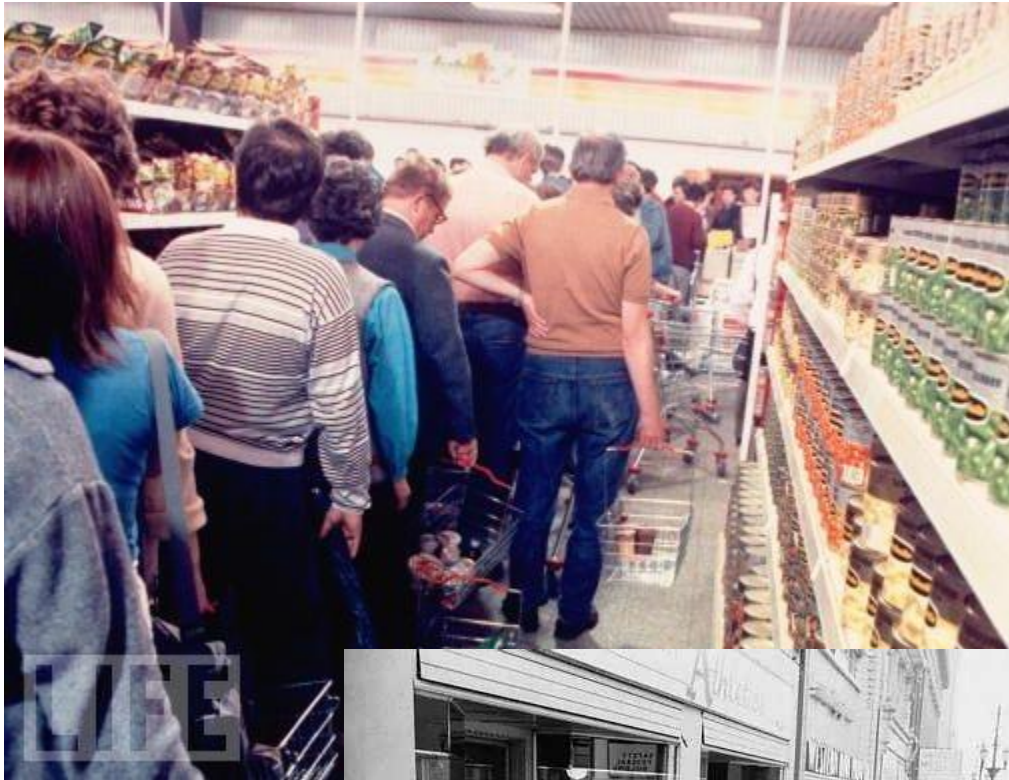

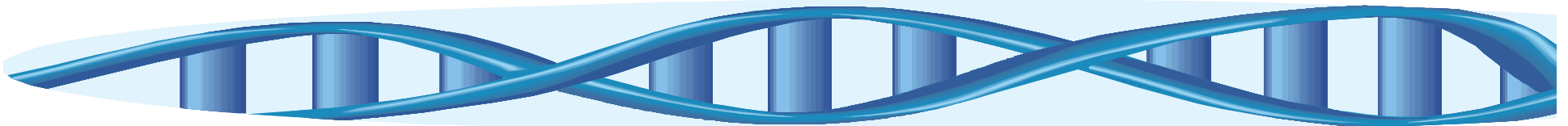

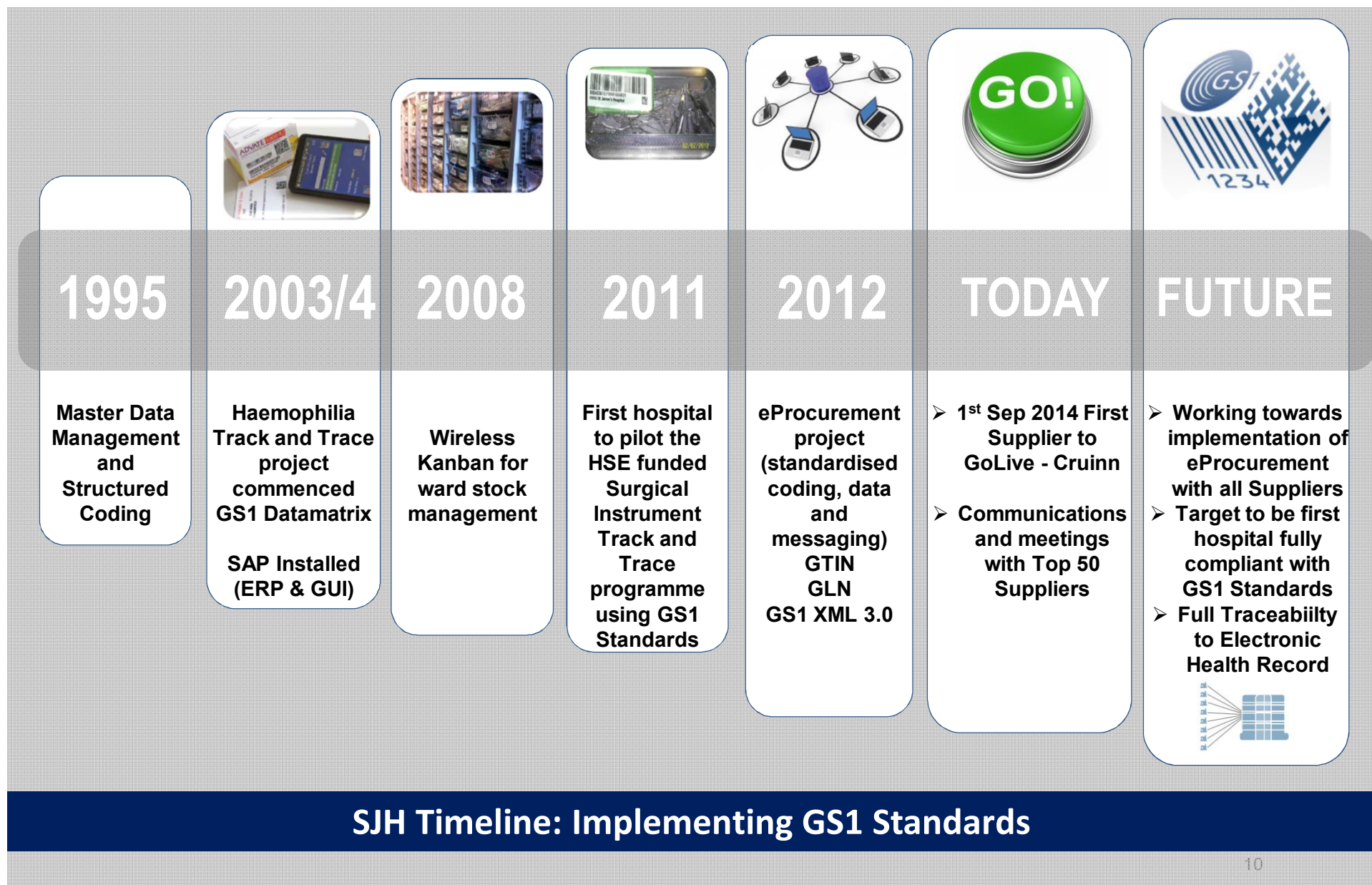

SJH Drivers For GS1 Adoption



Internal

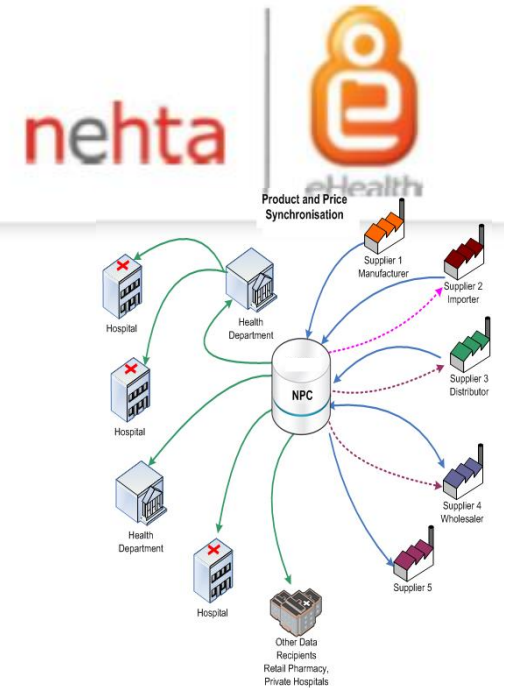
- ” Patient Safety
- ” Increase Supply Chain Efficiencies
- ” Patient Level Costing

External

- ” Increase in Product Recall
- ” Legislation (falsified medicines and medical devices (UDI))
- ” Policy Change (Money Follows Patient)
- ” Drive for cost savings

The Australian Model

NEHTA and GS1 = NPC



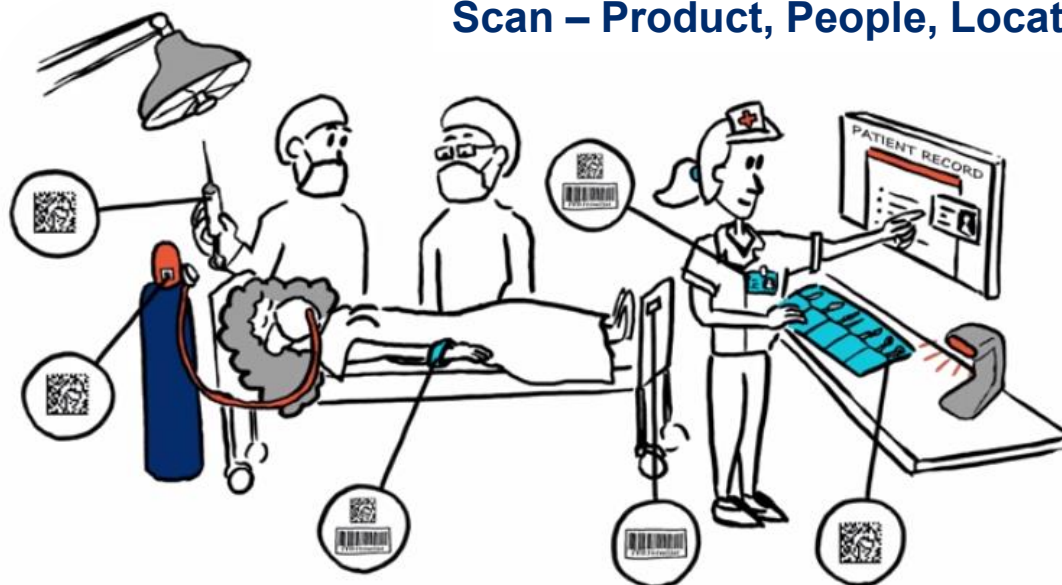
1. Lack of standardised **product** identification = **GTIN**
2. Lack of standardised **location** identification = **GLN**
3. Multiple product data catalogues being maintained per hospital, per hospital network and per state = **NPC**
4. Inaccurate and inefficient procurement practice = **eProcurement (GS1 XML)**



SJH Vision for Healthcare

The Scan at the Patient Bedside supports Patient Safety

Scan – Product, People, Location

- “ Replenishment of **Inventory**
- “ **Payment** of Invoice

The Paper Documents

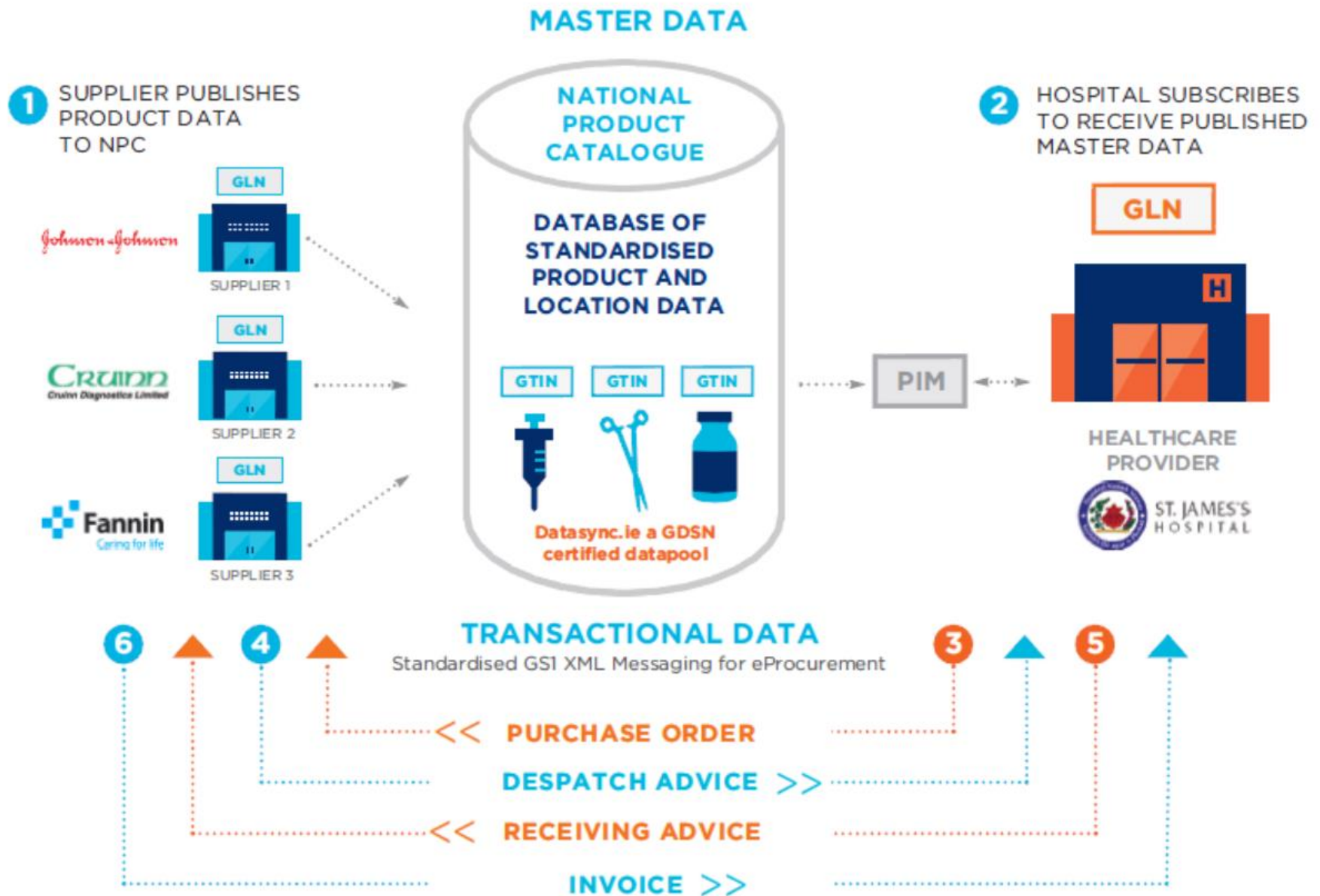
- “ Purchase Order
- “ Despatch Note
- “ Proof of Delivery
- “ Invoice
- “ Credit Note



Paper based, Manual processes

- “ Bad data leads to incorrect orders
- “ Time consuming - Information is manually re-keyed by Supplier and Hospital multiple times
- “ Risk of error
- “ Leads to many invoice disputes

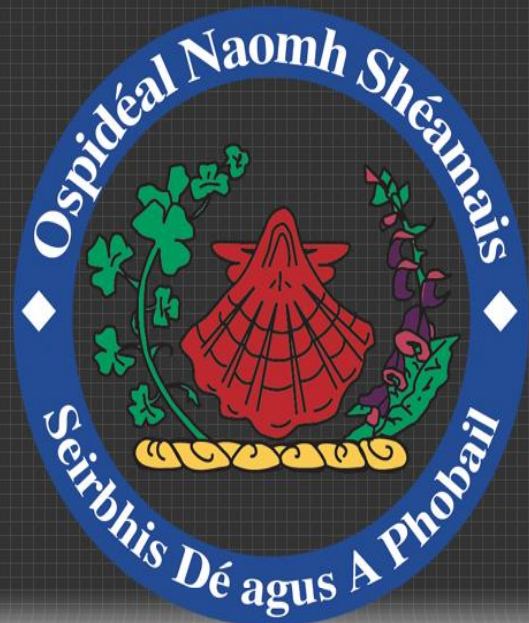


Supplier Adoption Curve
